This Hymn, written by Rev. J. S. Cutler, has its roots in the Mother-God theology of the 14th Century English mystic Dame Julian of Norwich. It was included in the 1941 Baptist/Disciples of Christ hymnal "Christian Worship". It's listed as "for Mother's Day", and puts an intriguing theological spin on this commercial holiday. It is interesting to note that folks in some Episcopal (Anglican) churches seem to groove on "Mothering Father" (taking "Mothering" as a better equivalent of "Merciful" in Hebrew, which is from the root "womb")
